Michelle French began her career with Denton County nearly 39 years ago. She was first elected as County Tax Assessor Collector in 2012 and is now in her third term. She earned her Registered Texas Assessor/Collector Certification in 1999 and currently holds and maintains a Professional County Collector Designation.

Her office collects for 135 jurisdictions and provides for the billing and collecting of over 600,000 parcels. The office has 6 branch locations around Denton County. In addition to property tax and assessment collections, the office provides motor vehicle registration and titling services for approximately 600,000 motor vehicles and over 130,000 title transfers.

Michelle serves as Ex Officio member of the Denton Central Appraisal District Board of Directors.

She completed 7 years of service on the Board of the Tax Assessor/Collectors Association of Texas (TACA) during which she served 3 years as Secretary/Treasurer, various positions on the Board, and had the distinct honor of serving as President 2018-2019. She received the TACA President's Award twice. She serves on several TACA Committees, including TxDMV Liaison chair.
